

REGISTRATION PROCESS:MILLS AND MANUFACTURERS

The U.S. Cotton Trust Protocol is the world's first sustainable cotton fiber program to offer its members article-level supply chain transparency through its proprietary Protocol Consumption Management Solution (PCMS). The proprietary solution utilizes the Protocol Platform and the TextileGenesis Platform to record and verify the movement of U.S. Cotton and Protocol Cotton throughout the entire supply chain.

Uploaded documents by mill and manufacturer members enable the PCMS to create a transparency map that shows the authenticated U.S. origin of the cotton fiber along with the names and locations of Trust Protocol members involved in all parts of the production process that ends with the shipment of the finished products to our brand and retailer members. The creates an unprecedented level of supply chain visibility down to the individual articles shipped between members along the way.

Companies looking to utilize the PCMS to track their consumption of U.S. Cotton and Protocol Cotton must:

- 1. Hold a valid Trust Protocol membership certificate and ID#
- 2. Record transactions in the PCMS that reflect what has been consumed physically in the manufacturing process
- 3. Agree to upload commercial invoices and shipping documents as required in the PCMS for each transaction with other Trust Protocol members

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the steps to get started and after membership completion?

Almost all suppliers get started in the program after receiving an invitation from a Trust Protocol brand or retail member that is seeking to scale their participation into value chains. However, even without an invitation your company can still enroll in the program.

How do I enroll in the Trust Protocol?

To enroll in the program, first visit www.trustuscotton.org and click the Join Now button.

What information is needed to enroll in the Trust Protocol?

In order to complete enrollment in the Trust Protocol, please have available the following information:

- Parent Company (including name, address and contact person)
- Manufacturing sites (including name, address(es) and contact person)
- · Manufacturing processes performed at each site
- Name and contact information of person with legal signing authority on behalf of the parent company

How long does it take to enroll?

The process takes approximately 15 minutes to complete.

What happens after I complete the application?

After completing the application a Program Manager reviews and after some validation steps a confirmation email will be sent with your approval, a program membership certificate and a unique member ID#.

The email will also contain a link to complete your overall application on the TextileGenesis system where you will:

- Register your parent company and enter the operations performed (defined as ROLES in system)
- Receive an email from TextileGenesis with approval and asking for a password to access the account
- Log into account and add manufacturing sites under the appropriate role (Yarn spinning, Fabric Making, Garment Making, etc.)
- Add the unique member ID# for each manufacturing site
