The U.S. Cotton Trust Protocol is a voluntary sustainability program for U.S. cotton growers and the traceability platform for all U.S. Cotton. In a time where sustainability and raw material sourcing are crucial for brands and retailers, mills and manufacturers are vital in ensuring transparency in the supply chain through the Protocol Consumption Management Solution (PCMS).

One unique feature of the Protocol Consumption Management Solution (PCMS) is to provide brand and retailer members with complete visibility of the identity and locations of each company involved in the process across the complete supply chain.

As a member, mill and manufacturers can then work with brand and retailer members in active sourcing of two distinct fibers:



U.S. Cotton tracked to the country level



Protocol Cotton tracked to a group of farms (participating Protocol growers)








### Here's how the process works

Mill and manufacturers who are interested in program participation should first apply for membership and accept the Code of Conduct. Membership will then be activated upon payment. Becoming a member will also enable registration on the TextileGenesis platform and allow your company to be identified as part of a fully transparent supply chain.

## For Garment Makers/Fabric Mills

- **Identify** the raw materials needed from vendors to meet Trust Protocol program requirements.
- **Inform** your vendors about joining the Trust Protocol and creating TextileGenesis accounts.
- Mark future fabric/yarn shipments for recording in TextileGenesis and communicate this to vendors.

## For Yarn Spinners

- Ask your U.S. Cotton merchants to upload shipment details to TextileGenesis.
- **Specify** if U.S. Cotton or Protocol Cotton is needed to meet your customer requirements.
- Your existing U.S. Cotton inventory can be made eligible under certain conditions
